

RULES TO BE USED INSTEAD OF THOSE ON THE BACK OF THE SCORECARD

1. OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 18.2)

- a. Beyond all fences, hedges and external boundaries surrounding the perimeter of the course;
- b. The practice ground as defined by the white stakes;
- c. The Clubhouse verandah, car parks and outhouses;
- d. On or beyond the driveway to the right of the 12th hole; and
- e. The South Winchester Lodges behind the 10th hole and to the right of the 17th hole.

2. PENALTY AREAS (Rule 17)

- a. Penalty areas are defined by either red or yellow stakes.
- b. The red penalty areas to the left hand side of the 7th and the right hand side of 15th extend to and coincide with the out of bounds edge.

3. 9TH HOLE, BEYOND AND LEFT OF GREEN

- a. Should a player find their ball over the path that leads round the clubhouse, beyond and left of the 9th green (but not out of bounds) then adding one penalty stroke, a player must drop a ball in the dropping zone marked by the white circle. The dropping zone is a relief area under Rule 14.3. If the ball is not found then Stroke and Distance applies (Rule 18.2b)

4. STAKED TREES AND SHRUBS (Rule 16.1)

- a. Staked trees and shrubs are No Play Zones. If such a tree or shrub interferes with the player's stance or the area of his intended swing, the player must take complete relief with a reference point no nearer the hole.

5. OTHER IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 16.1)

- a. Sprinkler Heads
- b. The public footpath as defined by the Blue stakes
- c. Tyre ruts (not faint impressions) and all man-made paths.
- d. The area to the right of the 12th Hole marked by the Blue stakes.

6. GROUND UNDER REPAIR (Rule 16.1)

- a. Ground under Repair areas are marked by white lines and are No Play Zones. The player must take complete relief with a reference point no nearer the hole.

7. PACE OF PLAY (Rule 5.6) and READY GOLF (Rule 6.4)

- a. Speed of Play is very important to everyone's enjoyment of golf. Play **READY GOLF!**
- b. Play when ready & able (no honour system);
- c. Walk ahead to your ball (but stay safe);
- d. Play your ball before looking for someone else's;
- e. Proceed to hole out when you can rather than marking your ball; and
- f. If you think that a group of players are getting behind, please phone the pro-shop on 01962873707.
- g. Our expectation is that 18 holes should take a maximum of 4 hours.
